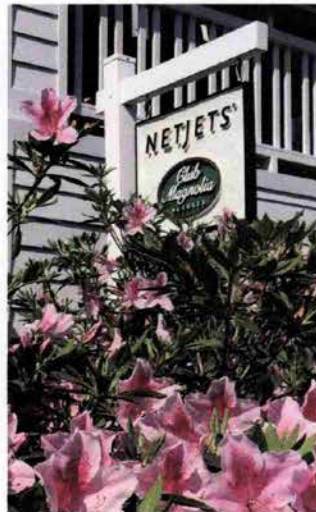

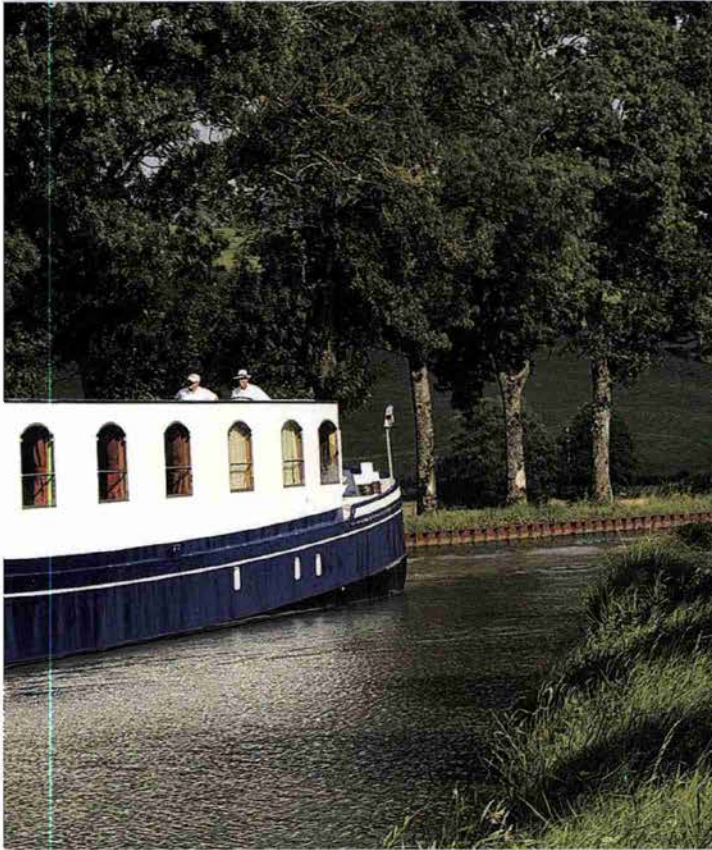


THE STANDARD IN VIP SUITES

BELMOND A FLOAT IN FRANCE WINE ACADEMY IN BURGUNDY, FRANCE

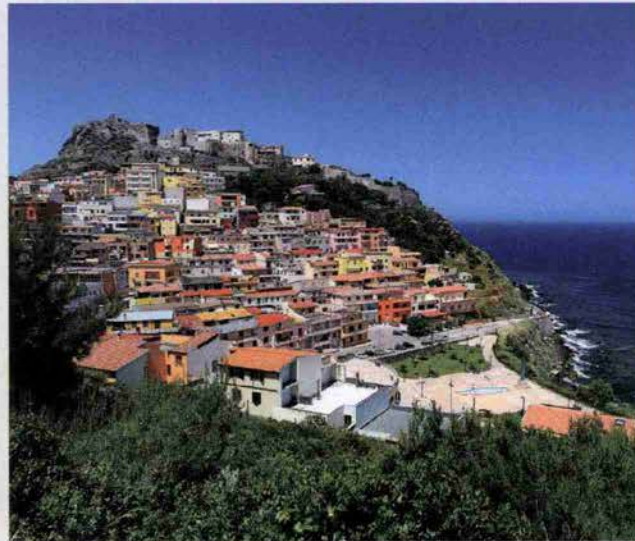

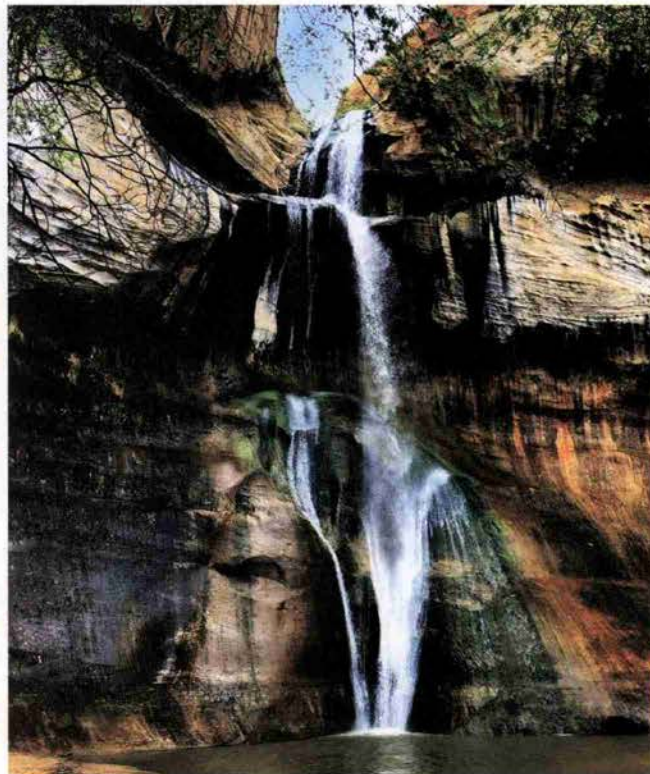


BEST APRÈS SKI ESCAPE
