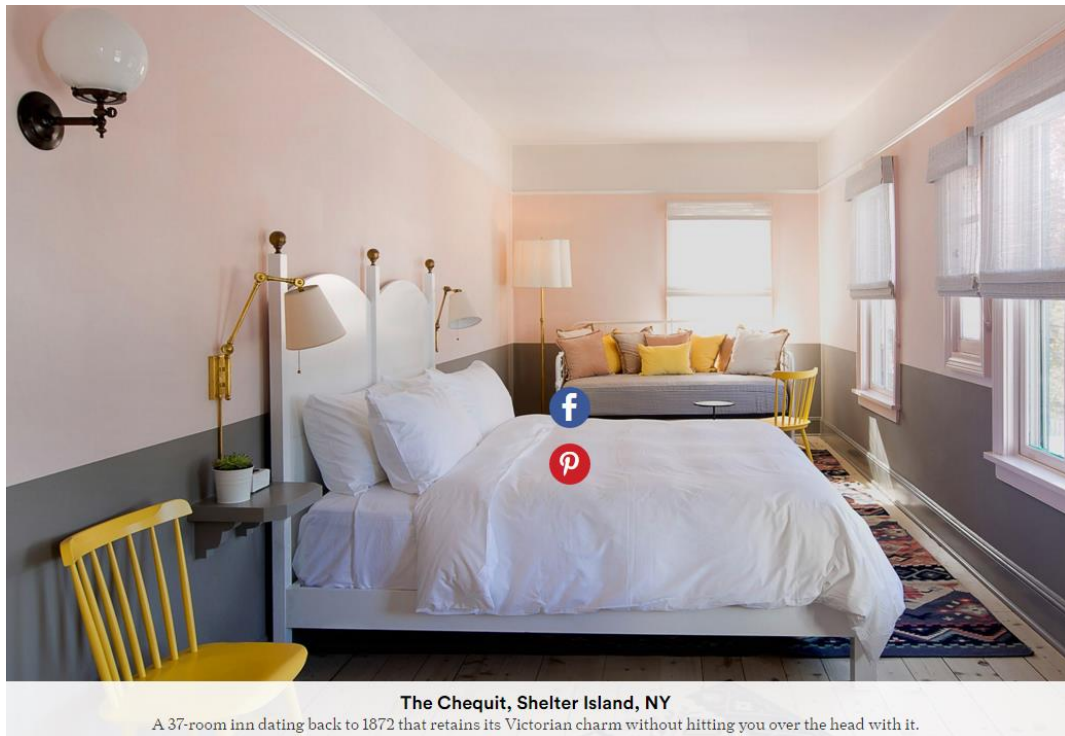
The Best New Hotels in the World: Hot List 2016

Our editors vetted hundreds of recently opened hotels and resorts, from West Africa to Miami, and found that what stands out are the properties that combine old-school extravagance and service with just the right measure of modernity. The Chequit, Shelter Island, NY

A 37-room inn dating back to 1872 that retains its Victorian charm without hitting you over the head with it.

It used to be the only way to stay in Shelter Island during the summer when its once-upon-a-time-on-an-island vibe was at its most palpable, was to either rent a house here or buy one as hotel options were thin at best. That all changed since the Salt Hotel group renovated The Chequit, a 37-room inn dating back to 1872 that retains its Victorian charm without hitting you over the head with it (no weak showers or uneven coffee tables here). Breakfast—yogurt, granola, in-house baked biscuits that crumble when you slather on the homemade jam—is served in the lobby each morning though you might want to have it delivered to your whitewashed room, sweetly wrapped picnic style. But if you do get yourself out of your bed (which is sure to show up on more than few Instagram accounts with its white, overstuffed duvet and double crescent headboard), sit out on the sweeping porch overlooking the nearby harbor. Or come back after sunset when wine on tap is meant to be sipped in a plush winged back chair out on the patio while you decide which beach you might bike to tomorrow. *Editor's Pick: Hot List 2016*
