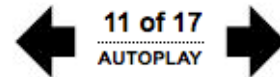
Last-Minute Summer Villas To Book Now

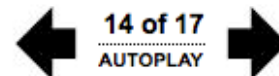
Lake Como, Italy: Villa La Cassinella
