## Juancho E. Yrausquin Airport (SAB), Saba

Surrounded by steep hills on one side, the sea on the other, and cliffs at either end of the world's shortest commercial runway (roughly 1,300 feet), the only airport on the minuscule Dutch island of Saba is definitely one of the world's scariest. Note that takeoffs can be equally white-knuckled affairs as tiny turbo-prop planes appear to drop off the end of the asphalt, and dip, ever so slightly, before gaining altitude.
